Siblings (at least 4 years of age) may participate, but they will be charged the \$5 fee. No children under 4 please, as they will not be permitted in the planetarium or workshop areas. Pre-registrations are non-refundable. In the event of a snow cancellation, your registration may be applied to a future program.
