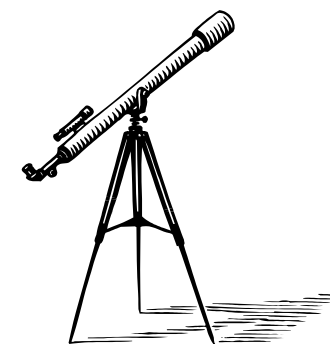

If you are registered for a family workshop/planetarium show at 10:30am or 11:30am, and you arrive later than your scheduled time, you will not be permitted to join the family workshop or planetarium show already in progress. Children under age 4 are not permitted in the family workshops/planetarium shows.

11:30am Family Workshop/Planetarium Show attendees should arrive early to complete Museum Quests, crafts and investigation stations before your scheduled family workshop/planetarium show.
