An Ordinance in Amendment of and in Addition to Chapter 1986-53 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence, approved October 23, 1986 and Entitled: "An Ordinance Approving and Adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for the Special Vacant Lot Project" for the Acquisition of Lots 438, 556, 420, 423, 425, 424, 560, 557, 429, 554, 447, 448, 449, 445, 450, 552, 446, 441, 443, 444, 455, 336, 454, 453, 335, 452, 451, 342, on Plat 63; 25 and 83 Aleppo Street; 1, 10, 14, 2, 30, 34 and 40 Curtis Street; 10, 14, 18, 2, 22, 23 and 6 Hillard Street; 150, 170, 174, 178, 183, 184, 190, 198, 204, 212 and 218 Manton Avenue, Respectively. - 2.) An Ordinance in Amendment of and in Addition to Chapter 1984-17 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence, approved March 9, 1984, Entitled: "An Ordinance Approving and Adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for the Upper South Providence Revitalization Project" for the Acquisition of Lots 438 and 439 on Assessor's Plat 45 and Lot 543 on Assessor's Plat 23, AKA 316 and 320 Prairie Avenue and 26 Myrtle Street. (*In City Council May 20, 2004 – Councilman Aponte and Councilman Hassett by Request*)
- 3.) Resolution Transferring the portion of the property located on Assessor's Plat 63, Lot 326 (50 Aleppo Street), commonly known as the Riverside Mill Building from the City of Providence to the Providence Redevelopment Agency with authorization to hold the property over the long-term and negotiate a lease with a non-profit organization. (*In City Council May 20, 2004 – Councilman Aponte and Councilman Hassett by Request*)
- 4.) Resolution Requesting the City Council to cause the transfer of the property located on Assessor's Plat 71, Lot 173, 591 Charles Street (24 Marietta Street) from the City of Providence to the Providence Redevelopment Agency, as stated in RIGL 45-32-26. Said property shall remain tax-exempt until said property is sold. (*In City Council August 5, 2004 – Councilwoman Romano by Request*)
- 5.) Resolution Requesting His Honor the Mayor to execute a deed and transfer the lot known as Assessor's Plat 63, Lot 555 (60 Curtis Street) to the Providence Redevelopment Agency. (*In City Council August 5, 2004 – Councilman Aponte and Councilman Hassett by Request*)
- 6.) Resolution Authorizing the Mayor of the City of Providence to execute a deed and transfer the lot known as Assessor's Plat 47, Lot 715 (267 Swan Street) to the Providence Redevelopment Agency. (*In City Council August 5, 2004 – Councilman Aponte by Request*)

- 7.) Resolution Requesting the Providence Redevelopment Agency to immediately commence proceedings to acquire the property located on Assessor's Plat 53, Lot 198 (1149 Broad Street) through eminent domain. ***(In City Council September 2, 2004 – Councilman Luna by Request – Referred to the Committee on Finance – Referred from Finance to URRP September 9, 2004)***
  
- 8.) Resolution Requesting the Department of Planning and Development commence by eminent domain of the property located on Assessor's Plat 53, Lot 565 (60 Sumter Street) and Assessor's Plat 60, Lot 106 (226-228 Sackett Street). ***(In City Council September 2, 2004 – Councilman Luna – Referred to the Committee on Finance – Referred from Finance to URRP September 9, 2004)***
  
- 9.) Resolution Requesting that the playground on Dudley Street be named the "Betty Ruth Williams Park." ***(In City Council July 1, 200 – Councilwoman Young)(Sent to Parks Department July 21, 2004)***
  
- 10.) Resolution Naming the Park located between Pleasant Valley Parkway and Rosebank Avenue situated next to Roger Williams Medical Center the; "Norman E. Fitton, Jr. Memorial Park". ***(In City Council September 2, 2004 – Councilmen Butler, DeLuca And Hassett)***
